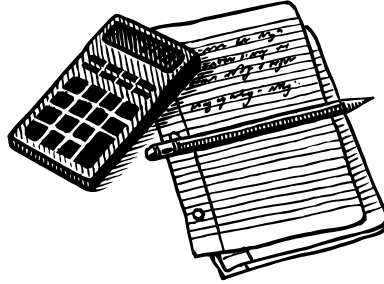


## Homework Tips for Parents



1. Have an agreement with your children on homework rules. Establish routines and expectations.
2. Set up a place for your children to do homework that includes good lighting, necessary supplies, and limited distractions.
3. Expect your children to do homework daily. Let them know that you think doing homework is a very important responsibility.
4. Supervise your children's homework whenever possible. Ask them to make a note of any problems requiring your assistance.
5. If your children have trouble, work through an example with them and encourage them to complete the rest themselves.
6. Be sure all homework is finished and placed in your children's backpacks **before they go to bed.**
7. Keep track of your children's homework assignments. Ask to see work returned or graded work by their teachers. Look for any recurring problems.
8. Contact your children's teachers if you do not understand their assignments.
9. Discuss teachers' homework expectations during parent-teacher conferences or at any time.
10. Praise your children for putting forth their best effort on a daily basis.
